#### Pre-Arrival Timeline



The managers of teams qualifying for the tournament should complete the following pre-arrival steps within the indicated time frames:

1. Within six (6) hours of qualifying for the tournament, e-mail the following information to [jredmond@suburbanice.com](mailto:jredmond@suburbanice.com): team name, local association, USA Hockey district name, manager's name, manager's home phone, fax and e-mail, manager's work phone, fax and e-mail.
2. Within twenty-four (24) hours of qualifying for the tournament, fax one copy of the following completed forms Attn: Jessica Redmond (517-336-4273): the tournament Team Entry Form and the tournament Team Roster Form. These must ALSO be faxed to the USA Hockey National Office Attn: Youth Department at 719-538-1160.
3. Within forty-eight (48) hours of qualifying for the tournament, e-mail a color high-resolution team photo in .jpeg format to Jessica Redmond at [jredmond@suburbanice.com](mailto:jredmond@suburbanice.com).
4. Within forty-eight (48) hours of qualifying for the tournament, contact Corey Morgan (866-468-3268) with Traveling Teams or visit [www.lansingsports.org/usah.aspx](http://www.lansingsports.org/usah.aspx) for lodging arrangements.
5. Within seventy-two (72) hours of qualifying for the tournament, contact Jeff Mitchell (517-336-4272) at Suburban Ice East Lansing Arena to schedule practice time(s) (if desired).
6. Within seventy-two (72) hours of qualifying for the tournament, fax tentative travel plans to Mike Price (517-487-5151). Please use the document titled "Participant Arrival & Departure Schedules."
7. Within seventy-two (72) hours of qualifying for the tournament, contact your District Registrar (see contact list within the Credentials section of this handbook) for instructions regarding your credentials.
8. As soon as possible, and no later than March 18, 2010, fax the completed Easton Skills Challenge Nomination Form to the Youth Department at the USA Hockey National Office at 719-538-1160.

Any team qualifying for Nationals on or after March 23, 2010 (14 days prior to the start of Nationals) should attempt to complete all the above steps within forty-eight (48) hours of qualifying.

Both arenas have many things to offer, locker rooms are spacious and ancillary amenities are excellent. Suburban Ice East Lansing features two NHL-sized playing surfaces while The Summit offers one NHL-sized playing surface and one Olympic surface. Both facilities offer full concession stands for all needs and an Arcade for brothers and sisters to pass the time. #### **5. Pro Shop**

Perani’s Hockey World is located in both facilities and has everything that your player will need to have success. They offer everything from a full line of protective equipment, mouthguards, tape, apparel, equipment repair and skate sharpening. #### **6. Opening Coaches/Managers Meeting**

A meeting for all team officials will be held at Radisson Hotel on **Tuesday April 6th, at 7:30 p.m.** Per USA Hockey Rules & Regulations, **each team must have at least one representative at this meeting. A representative is defined as either the coach or the team manager.** This person will be designated as the delegation chairperson for his/her team and will be the team’s official liaison for all official contacts between the team and the tournament committee. The team’s manager should fulfill this role, if at all possible. The team’s head coach should also attend the pre-tournament meeting, if possible. **Failure to have a representative at this meeting will result in the coach not being allowed on the bench for the first game.**

#### **7. Ticket Prices**

All persons five years of age and older must have a ticket in order to enter the arena.

Prices are as follows:

- Adults (18 and over): Day Ticket, \$10
- Adults (18 and over): Tournament Pass, \$30
- Senior : Day Ticket, \$5
- Senior : Tournament \$15
- Children (5 -17): Day Ticket, \$5
- Children (5 -17): Tournament Pass, \$15
- Kids (4 and under): FREE

Tickets may be purchased at the front desk of Suburban Ice East Lansing on Tuesday and Wednesday and at both facilities during the tournament.

#### **8. Tickets for Team Personnel**

Each team will receive one (1) tournament pass per registered player and rostered team official (manager and coaches).

#### **9. Team Procedures**

It is vital that all necessary team procedures are completed in accordance with the information given in this team handbook.

#### **10. Hotel Security**

It is the policy of USA Hockey that officials of each team are responsible for all matters regarding the behavior and conduct of all persons associated with their teams. It is especially critical that each team provide security within its section(s) of the tournament hotels. This

security is in addition to that normally provided by the hotel's management. Details regarding this process are found in the document titled "Hotel Security."

**11. Practice Ice Arrangements**

Ice time for practice is available at Suburban Ice East Lansing at the rate of \$150.00 per hour. Arrangements for practice time must be made through Jeff Mitchell, General Manager, at [jmitchell@suburbanice.com](mailto:jmitchell@suburbanice.com) or 517-336-4272.

**12. Tournament Souvenirs**

A variety of USA Hockey licensed souvenirs will be available for sale in the lobby of Suburban Ice East Lansing. The merchandise stand, which will be located in the lobby, will open 30 minutes prior to the first game and close 30 minutes after the last game of the day begins.

**13. Easton Skills Challenge**

Each qualifying team is required to participate in the Easton Skills Challenge. Each team is required to select one skater and one goaltender to participate. The Skills Challenge will take place on Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 pm-8:30 pm for the 12U and 14U divisions (12U 5:30-7 pm and 14U 7-8:30 pm). The 16U and 19U divisions will have their Skills Challenge on Thursday, April 8<sup>th</sup> from 6 pm-9 pm (16U 6-7:30 pm and 19U 7:30-9 pm). Easton Skills Challenge will be held at Suburban Ice East Lansing.

# Youth & Girls'/Women's Regulations for District Playoffs & National Championships

**Credentials**

General Comments:

Each team must be certified with regard to its eligibility to compete in the National Tournament. Similarly, each coach and player must also be certified before participating in the tournament. The instructions outlined in this document must be followed closely so that no problems develop concerning eligibility questions.

Please contact your District Registrar (see attached contact list) within 72 hours of having qualified for the National Tournament for instructions. The designated person will review the credentials for completeness and accuracy. The designated person will complete and sign off on the Team Roster Registration Certification form (2-C) and the Credentials Verification Sheet (1-C). The designated person will send a copy of the Official Team Roster (1-T), the Team Roster Registration Certification Form (2-C) and the Credential Verification Sheet (1-C) to the designated tournament credentials committee contact. The team’s credentials package will be returned to the team and this entire package must be taken by the team to the tournament and it must be available for inspection by the tournament credentials committee at any time.

If before, during, or after the tournament the Credentials Committee becomes aware of and later determines that a player or players is/are ineligible, said player(s) shall be ruled ineligible for any/all remaining games, and the team using the ineligible player(s) will forfeit any/all games in which the player(s) participated. If it is proved that the team’s coach and/or manager was/were aware of the situation, said coach and/or manager will be reported to USA Hockey for possible disciplinary action.

**Presentation Requirements:**

Certifying teams, coaches and players is a time-consuming and complex task. In order to make this process as efficient as possible, each team’s credentials must be presented in a manner that is highly organized and systematic. No team’s credentials will be examined unless they are organized according to the following guidelines:

- I. All materials must be in a three-ring binder.
- II. It is suggested that each item be placed inside a sheet protector.
- III. Each section of the notebook shall be identified by a divider tab with the title of the section displayed.
- IV. Information will be presented in the following order:

## **Required Information:**

- A. **Team Information** (in order of presentation)
  - 1. Certified Team Roster (1-T) approved by the team's USA Hockey District Registrar.
  - 2. Game Verification Sheet (1-C).
  - 3. Sanctioned game score sheets, arranged chronologically from the first game on, to be used to verify team and player eligibility under the 20/10 or 14/10 rule.
  
- B. **Coaches' Information\*** (in order of presentation for each individual)
  - 1. Signed USA Hockey Waiver Form, if not registered online.
  - 2. Signed USA Hockey Consent to Treat Form.
  - 3. Signed USA Hockey Participant Code of Conduct Form.
  - 4. Proof of appropriate CEP level, as mandated by the district in which the coach is registered, must appear on the Team's Official Roster or Supplemental Roster or be provided by way of a photo copy of CEP card (front and back).
  
- C. **Manager's Information\*** (in order of presentation for each individual)
  - 1. Signed USA Hockey Waiver Form.
  - 2. Signed USA Hockey Consent to Treat Form.
  - 3. Signed USA Hockey Participant Code of Conduct Form.
  
- D. **Players' Information\*** (in order of presentation for each individual)
  - 1. Copy of government issued birth certificate or copy of a passport ID page for each rostered player (birth certificates issued by hospitals are not acceptable).
  - 2. Non-US citizens must provide proof of legal residency and proof of release and transfer from home country ice hockey federation if required.
  - 3. USA Hockey Waiver Form (signed by player and parent/legal guardian), if not registered online.
  - 4. USA Hockey Consent to Treat Form (signed by player and parent/legal guardian).
  - 5. Signed USA Hockey Participant Code of Conduct Form.

\*Copies of IMR's are required for each Coach, Player and Manager if the team utilized paper registration instead of the USA Hockey/Cybersport Registration software.
